



Dear Landowner,

The Mid-Kaweah Groundwater Sustainability Agency (Mid-Kaweah GSA) Emergency Ordinance (EO) was enacted on May 1, 2022 due to the groundwater depletions occurring in the Kaweah Subbasin. The Mid-Kaweah GSA along with the two other GSAs in the Kaweah Subbasin have adopted similar programs to manage groundwater overdraft by limiting and allocating a specific amount to be used within a Water Year (WY).

In the Mid-Kaweah GSA, there will be two invoices sent out each WY. The first invoice of the WY is called The Reservation Invoice, and the water account holder can choose to reserve none, partial or all of the allocation each year 45 days after receiving an invoice. The Reservation Invoice automatically shows full allocation purchase by default. When a water account holder purchases allocation for the WY, the intent is to use the allocation within the WY or save unused allocation for the following WY(s), and the allocation purchased is displayed on the Kaweah Water Dashboard. The second invoice of the WY is called The True-Up Invoice, and the True-Up Invoice shall come after the end of the WY. The True-Up Invoice can either be the amount owed due to exceeding the allocation or groundwater cap or indicate any groundwater credits that can be carried over to the next WY or placed into market.

### **Water Year 2023 True-Up Invoice**

(October 1, 2022 - September 30, 2023)

The True-Up Invoice for Water Year 2023 (WY2023) will arrive by mail. A water account holder can purchase the allocation for WY2023 which was 2.5 AF/acre as well as any overages. The True-Up Invoice will have evapotranspiration data and carry over water credits.

### **Water Year 2024 Reservation Invoice**

(October 1, 2023 - September 30, 2024)

The Reservation Invoice for Water Year 2024 (WY2024) will arrive by mail. A water account holder can reserve the available allocation for WY2024 which is 2.38 AF/acre. The WY2024 invoice will not have evapotranspiration data or carry over water credits.
